BIOGRAPHY

The artist was born in Naples, Italy; raised in Naples and Padua; and moved to New York City in 1983, where she has been working since.

From 1986 to 1990, her work was represented by the Laurie Rubin Gallery in New York, where she had solo shows in November 1986, March 1988 and October 1989.

From 1990 to 2005, Nazor continued painting and showing her work privately. In 2006, Nazor began exhibiting her work publicly again, participating in "Civil Restitutions", a group exhibition at the Thomas Dane Gallery, London, and currently in 2009, in the group exhibition "Broken Thorn, Sweet Blackberry" at Sikkema Jenkins and Co., New York.

Her paintings are in private and public collections in the US and in Europe.

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
